As we keep reminding them, it is just an opportunity to show how they have progressed during their time at CHPS. We are incredibly proud of how they have tackled the challenges over the last few years and their caring, supportive natures have really shone.

To start each day with a positive approach, we have decided to offer **ALL** Year 6 children a breakfast club on **Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday** of SATs week. Nutritionists are constantly reminding us that breakfast is the most important meal of the day as it fuels the body for the day ahead. Schools that have offered breakfast club in this week have found that it has a positive effect on reducing stress levels as the children are able to start the day in a relaxed, supportive environment with their peers and teachers.

We will be offering food such as toast, cereal, sausage/vegetarian sausage baps and bacon baps alongside some juice which will all be served by the Year 6 team. Some breakfast items have been kindly provided with the help of Morrisons which we are very grateful. **As we do not currently have a PTA to help fund this provision, we kindly ask for a voluntary contribution paid via Arbor of £2.50 per child to help cover the cost.**

Doors will be opened to **Year 6** children at 8:00am each morning (Monday to Thursday) and we will aim to finish breakfast by 8:40am. If your child has any allergies, please let us know.
