

Bulb Planting - Greenbank

Dear Parents and Friends of Castle Hill,

We are excited to welcome you back onto our school grounds for our traditional bulb planting event! We have planned the event so that each class will have enough room to spread out safely. In order for this to happen, each class has a designated time slot and space over the Thursday 4th November and Friday 5th November 2021. If you would like to join your child in planting a bulb around the school ground, please can we ask that each child only has **one** adult (no siblings) attend the bulb planting.

Can we please ask you to provide your child/children with a change of shoes i.e. Wellington boots or spare trainers as the school grounds may be damp on the day. As this is a whole school activity, we would like to ask each family if possible to bring in their own safe tools. These should be labelled with the child's name on them, so that we can return them to you. The school will provide some tools, but as you can imagine there will only be a limited amount available.

We would appreciate any bulb donations – large or small – towards this event, if these could please be brought into school by the **Friday 22nd October**, that will allow us enough time to share out the bulbs between the classes.
