SCHOOL HARDSHIP FUND:



Following a very generous donation to the school a Hardship Fund was set up and is topped up using the donations collected from mufti-days, school fundraising events and other voluntary contributions. The funds are limited and are largely dependent on the generous contributions from our school community.

We obviously can't support everyone and try to ensure that the funds are suitably distributed and reach out to our families with extreme, unique and compelling one-off cases.
