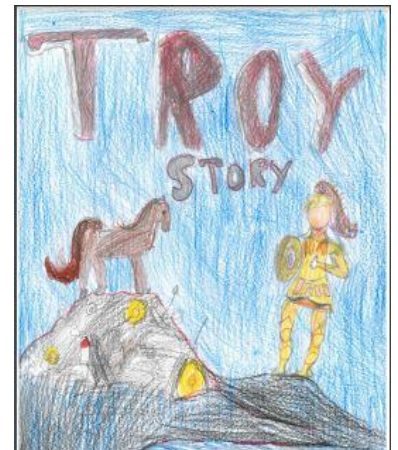
School Dinners: Please remember to pre-order and pay for school dinners via Scopay. If you need to register for a Scopay link email admin@chjs.net
