Our PE & Sport Premium funding helps every child enjoy high-quality PE, physical activity and sport. During 2025–2026 the school received **£21,949** to enhance opportunities across both school sites.

How the funding is being used

Keeping Children Active (£12,278)

- Lunchtime sports clubs
- New playground and PE equipment
- Playground markings
- Equipment servicing and pitch inspections

Developing Staff (£2,041)

Training and professional development for teachers, PE leaders and lunchtime staff to improve PE teaching.

Providing More Sporting Experiences (£6,931)

Dance workshops, new sports including skipping and ultimate frisbee, plus Year 6 swimming booster lessons.

Competitive Sport (£700)

Membership of the local PE & Sport partnership and support for pupils attending competitions.

Raising the Profile of PE

Regular governor meetings, newsletters and reports celebrate PE and encourage healthy, active lifestyles. These activities use existing staff and do not incur additional costs.
