Children should arrive at school for normal time in the morning and we will be back during the school day so your child can either order a school lunch or have a packed lunch at school as normal. The children need to wear school uniform for the trip.

If your child has an inhaler or is on any medication on the day of the visit, we will take these with us from school. If your emergency contact number for the day will be different to the number we have on file, please ensure you make us aware.

Finally, if you would like to help, please let your child's class teacher know and we will contact if you are needed. However, we may have to ask you to meet us at the venue. We love having parents come and share in their children's learning.
