At Castle Hill Primary School, our children will explore their own, and a wide range of other beliefs and religions. It is a statutory requirement that schools teach religious education as prescribed by the locally agreed syllabus. Although, as identified by the Education Reform Act, parents do have the right to withdraw their children from parts of, or all, RE lessons.
