If you are from an HCC school or college and you do not have a login, please use Guest Access and go to the STAS Key Information Course to complete the on-line form to request a login.

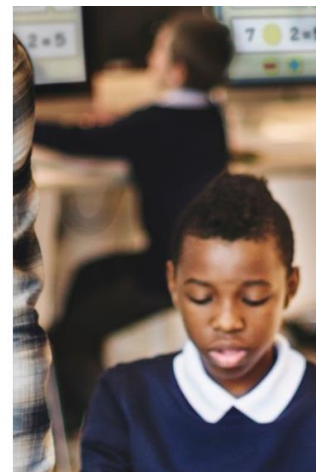
If you are from an HCC organisation with a hants.gov.uk email address, then you should be able to self-register by clicking 'Create new account' below.

Please note that your username should be **firstname.surname** in lower case letters.



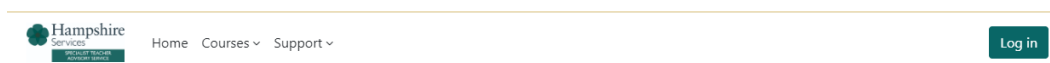


Once you log in, scroll down to find the 'Quick Links'.

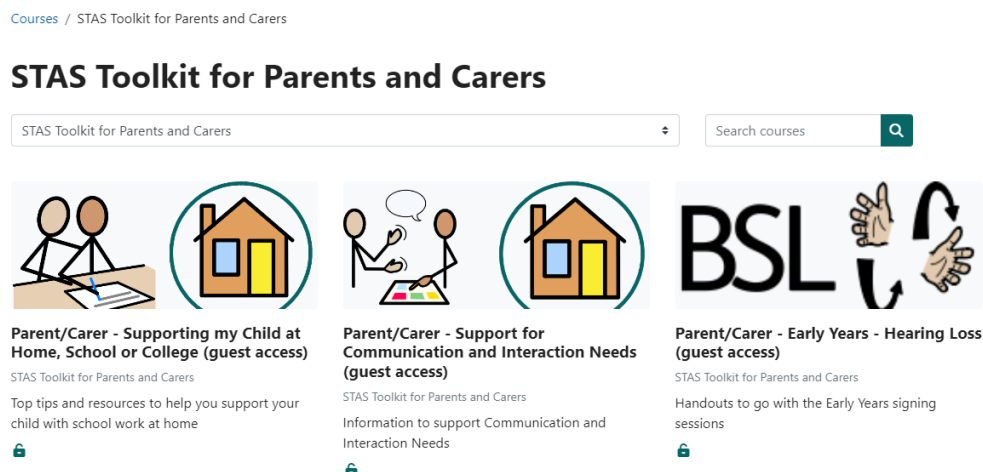
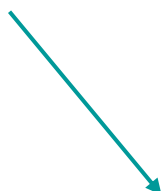
Click to enter the **Toolkit for Parents and Carers** or the **Toolkit for Children and Young People**.
