This term we are planning a science workshop for Year R. To enrich the children's understanding of our Science topics, we have organised for the science workshop to come into school. This will give the children the opportunity to explore science in an interactive way. The children will get to be involved in exciting experiences:

We have two workshops planned:

Rainbow Bubble - Reveal the secret of white light when we see rainbows in the classroom. Play with special touchable bubbles and create their own bubbles with a fizzy chemical reaction!

Transport Workshop (extreme transport) - The children will look at why a hot air balloon rises up and launch a rocket skywards as we learn about the basics of forces within this fun workshop. We will make our own straw rockets and Paper Stunt Planes, and even see how we can move a teacher around on our homemade hover-board.

We are requesting a contribution of **£13.00** for this activity. This amount is calculated assuming that each child takes part and makes a contribution to ensure we raise sufficient funds.
