- Create a poster or information leaflet advertising a Roman museum, thinking carefully about the exhibitions that may be included.
- Plan a trip across the UK, visiting only Roman towns and using as many Roman roads as possible.
- Research Roman Gods and Goddesses and present them in any way you like (posters, PowerPoint presentations, etc.)
- Make a 3D model of a Roman artefact.
- Write your own Roman poem.

We cannot wait to see what the children create! We hope you have a fantastic half term and look forward to seeing the children on Monday 24th February.
