Year 6 Stubbington Trip 2026

Dear Parents and Friends of Castle Hill,

Further to our recent communication regarding the Year 6 residential trip to Stubbington, we thank you for registering your child's interest and paying the deposit to secure their place. We can now confirm that we have secured the week of **Monday 14th September to Friday 18th September 2026**.

The total cost of the trip, including the return coach travel, is £291.00. As you have paid the initial deposit of £50.00, the balance remaining is £241.00. You will be able to make payments, via Arbor, for the trip between now and July. If you would like to pay for the majority of the trip in one payment this is also an option. Below is a suggested payment schedule and reminders will be sent.

We do ask that your child's trip is paid for **in full by 17th July 2026**, as this is when the school must settle the final invoice.

Stubbington Kit List

- Trainers and wellington boots (these are needed for beach activities)
- At least one pair of long trousers/tracksuit bottoms (Even in hot weather, children will be asked to wear long trousers when working around some areas, to help keep them safe from ticks)
- Extra socks and underclothing for the week
- Waterproof coat or warm coat
- Gloves, hat, extra sweaters etc. in colder times of the year
- Sun hats and sun cream in warmer times of year
- Water bottle
- Pyjamas or nightdress, slippers and dressing gown
- Wash kit (including toothbrush and toothpaste), in a bag, NO AEROSOLS
- Named shower cap & bobbles or similar for long hair
- Two distinctive towels (one to be used as a hand towel)
- Games clothes
- Binoculars, cameras and torches are worth bringing, but children will be expected to care for their own property. **No electrical items or other valuables should be brought** eg. No mobile phones, personal stereos or electronic games.
