Dear Parents,

After much anticipation, the time is finally here! On Monday 13<sup>th</sup> we will be leaving Castle Hill for Stubbington for our residential trip. We are as excited as the children. Within the PowerPoint shared in the Summer term (found here under Year 6 Letters - <u>Stubbington Presentation</u>), there was a suggested equipment list however, if you are unable to provide a waterproof coat or wellies (or other shoes suitable for outside) the centre is able to provide spares. We are of course, hoping for nice weather!

## <u>Greenbank</u>

Please arrive with your child at the normal time on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> September. At 8:45 we will open the gate on Winklebury Way to allow the children to bring their suitcases up onto the top playground. Staff will be available to assist as unfortunately we are unable to invite you into the school grounds. Both Mrs Thomas and Miss Lounton will be at the gate to take any medications that you may have.

You are welcome to wait along the road on Winklebury Way to wave off the coach which aims to leave by 9 am. If you are planning on waving us off, please can we ask that you wait on opposite side of the road so that you do not obstruct the parents dropping off at the Infant School. If your child suffers from travel sickness please give them the medication to take prior to the coach journey on Monday and give the return tablet to Mrs Thomas or Miss Lounton.

## <u>Rooksdown</u>

Please arrive with your child at the normal time on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> September. At 8:35 we will open the park gate to allow the children to bring their suitcases up onto the No Mow area. Staff will be available to assist as unfortunately we are unable to invite you into the school grounds. Mr Barraclough will be at the gate to take any medications that you may have. If your child suffers from travel sickness please give them the medication to take prior to the coach journey on Monday and give the return tablet to Mr Barraclough.

You are welcome to wait along the road by the Community Centre to wave off the coach which aims to leave by 9 am. If you are planning on waving us off, please can we ask that you are mindful of parents dropping younger children off and you don't obstruct the entrance.

We will be updating Dojo throughout the week. Please bear with us as signal isn't great in the Stubbington area and we are also very busy with the children until lights out. We will send a text via the admin team once we have arrived.

When we return to school on Friday 17<sup>th</sup>, we will send a text message via admin to let you know our expected arrival time. We aim to leave Stubbington after lunch at 1pm. The children will then be dismissed from the top playground (Greenbank) and No Mow area (Rooksdown). On arrival, please speak to the member of staff on the park/Winklebury gate.
