| Maths | We will learn how to find the area and perimeter of rectilinear shapes. We will be using our known times tables facts and place value knowledge to solve more complex additions and multiplications, such as 30 x 7 and 40 x 5. We will look at a range of shapes and their properties, such as angles and lines of symmetry. We will also be able to identify coordinates when placed on a grid. We will compare and convert different measurements (m/km, l/ml). We will read and convert times on an analogue clock as well as 12 and 24 hour clocks. |
