When is the Spring Performance?

- Monday 23rd March – This is a dress rehearsal and no parents are invited
- Wednesday 25th March 2 pm – 3 pm (Performance 1)
- Thursday 26th March 9 am – 10 am (Performance 1)

Where is the Spring Performance held?

The Spring Performance will be held in our main school hall. Please come to the front gates where you will be let in and directed to the external hall door. Your tickets will be scanned, and you will be able to find somewhere to sit inside.

How do I watch the Spring Performance? – Ticket booking

You will need to book a ticket to watch the performance, and these will be made available on **Monday 16th March at 4pm**. Instructions on how to book are on the next page.

Tickets are free, although we do welcome cash donations at the performance. Any donations will go towards covering the costs of putting on the show e.g. Performance Licence, props and staging etc.

Please have your tickets available to scan on your phone as you approach the hall. This will help getting into the hall run smoothly.

Who can come?

Due to fire safety restrictions, **tickets are limited to two tickets per child.**

We discourage any toddlers attending, but if they do, they will need their own seat. This will impact your numbers, and their ticket will have to be booked using one of the passwords sent. If young children become upset during the performance, we ask that parents are considerate and leave the hall. It can distract our young actors.

Ticket Booking Process

(maximum of 2 tickets per child):

1. Each parent/guardian will receive an email titled 'Password for Spring Performance'.
2. As a password is linked to the primary guardian and not the child you will need both passwords if you want to book 2 tickets.
3. Go to the school website (www.castlehillprimary.net)
4. Find the event link you are looking for e.g. Year 1 & 2 Spring Performance

5. Select the performance (time/date) you would like to book
6. Click on the event link and you will be taken to the Trybooking website
7. Copy and paste your password (2 passwords for every child performing) into the password box at the top right of this page.
8. Book your ticket. Repeat the process again to use the second password to book the second ticket
9. You will receive a booking confirmation email once the form has been completed.

Please note, if there are no tickets available on your chosen day, you can put your name on the waiting list.
