During the Autumn term, we have been learning about Hinduism and the importance of generosity. We have chosen to celebrate this topic by inviting the Hinduism Education Services into school. They will be visiting to teach the children about Hindu worship, culture, values and lifestyle, which will include storytelling, dressing up in traditional Indian costume and other exciting activities!
