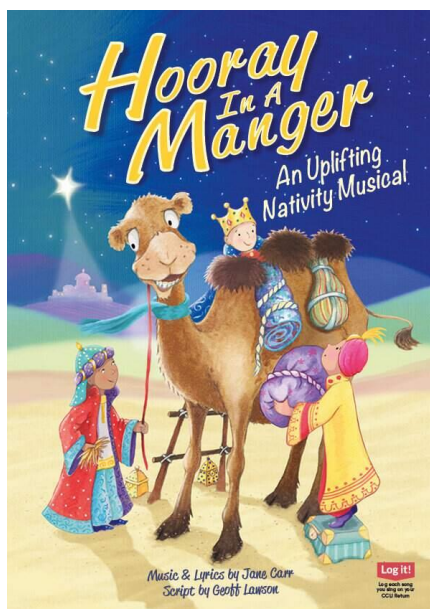

Dear Parents Carers,

We are excited to announce that our year 3/4 Christmas Production this year is **Hooray in a Manger!**

There are several parts in this play, and we will be asking the children if they would like to audition. There are a range of roles including; larger speaking roles, a smaller speaking role, a shared speaking part and non-speaking roles. There are also 3 roles which include a singing solo.

If your child would like to audition for a speaking role, please may they learn one of the shepherd's lines from Scene 6 (on the back of this letter). If they would like to audition for a singing solo, we will ask them to perform a well-known song on the day. We will be holding auditions on Friday 18th October, with the hope that scripts can be sent out over half term. We will of course do our best to accommodate the children's requests.
