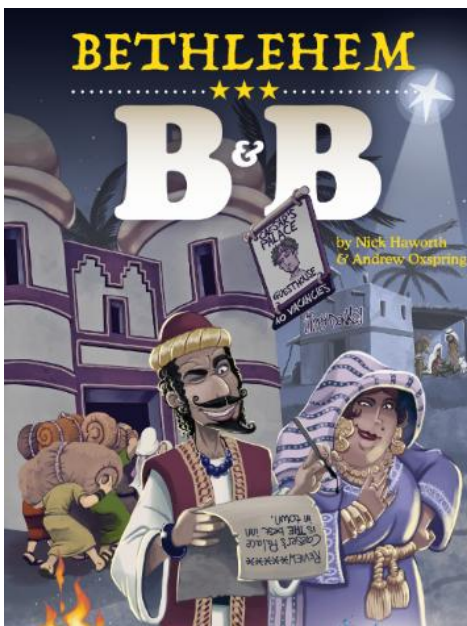

There are several parts in this play. We will be asking the children if they would like a larger speaking role, a smaller one, to share a speaking part or a non-speaking role. There is one male and one female part which include a singing solo. There is also a male/female singing duet.

If your child would like to audition for a speaking role, please could they learn one of the narrators' lines from Scene 8 (below).

If they would like to audition for a singing solo, we will ask them to perform a well-known song without backing music on the day. We will be holding auditions on Monday 20th October, with the hope that scripts can be sent out over half term. We will of course do our best to accommodate the children's requests.
