## **Topic: Egyptians**

English	Reading We will be recapping all of our reading skills this half term and focusing on answering test style questions. We will look at information texts which link with our History and Science topics.  Writing We will be learning about newspapers and having a go at writing our own all about the discovery of King Tutankhamun's tomb.
