Summer one topics

Ancient Greeks

<p>English</p>	<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>This half term, the children will be using a variety of reading skills, for example: summarising, taking quotes from non-fiction, identifying the effect of language on the reader and identifying presentational features of different text types.</p> <p><u>Writing</u></p> <p>During this half term, the children will be focusing their writing on our Ancient Greek topic. Firstly, they will be writing an informative leaflet about Ancient Greek armour and weapons. After this, they will be looking at Greek myths and will create a fact file about their own Ancient Greek creature. The will finally use this to create the start of their own myth.</p> <p><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>For spelling this half term, the children will be learning about different suffixes and how they can be used to change word classes (inform = verb – information – adjective). They will also be focusing on checking their own work for spelling mistakes and how to spell different homophones.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p><u>Geometry</u></p> <p>We will be learning how to find missing properties of shapes, identify regular polygons. We will also be reflecting and translating these shapes.</p> <p><u>Fractions</u></p> <p>We will be revising some content from earlier on in the year but will be mainly focusing on solving problems involving making links between decimals, percentages and fractions.</p> <p><u>Multiplication and division</u></p> <p>We will be focusing on finding cubed numbers, common factors and prime factors.</p> <p><u>Measurement</u></p> <p>The children will be working out problems, including word problems, involving money.</p>
<p>History</p>	<p>This terms topic is Ancient Greece. The children will learn about how they lived, fought, what they believed and why it is still important to learn about them today.</p>
<p>Computing</p>	<p>Websites</p>

Art	The skill the children will be looking at is sculpture. They will be making their own creative spin on an Ancient Greek mask using papier-mâché.
PSHE	<u>Looking at the world</u> The children will be researching, discussing and debating topical issues, problems and events. They will look at the rights and responsibilities within a society and show an awareness of the idea of collective and individual responsibility to find solutions to community issues.
RE	This term, the children will be looking at religious laws and stories exploring how important this is to people.
PE	This term, the children will be focusing on their use of fluid movement to quickly complete challenges in a variety of team games.
Year 5 PE days are:	Monday and Tuesday. They will need their PE kits at school on both of these days and their daily move shoes in a separate bag.
Homework Routines	Spellings are handed out on a Monday and the children will be tested the following week. Maths homework, which is online, is set on a Friday and is due the following Thursday. Reading should be completed at least 4 times a week and written in their diary alongside a parent's/ guardian's signature.
