We have organised for Altitude Events to set up a day of fun activities on the school field for the children to enjoy on **Thursday 7th July**. We have booked a range of activities to take place on the Greenbank school field during the school day. Instead of doing their usual lessons, the children will get to play crazy golf, climb a rock wall, play laser tag and tackle an inflatable obstacle course. We would like to thank both CHPS Fundraising Friends groups who have contributed £1,500 towards the trip. If your child attends the Rooksdown Campus, they will need to arrive at school as normal at 8.35am. We will walk to the Greenbank Campus together before walking back again at the end of the day.

In order to get the most from the day, we will be having a picnic lunch on the school field (slightly later than normal). Please bring a packed lunch from home (no nut products please) or order a school picnic meal via Scopay either Ham or Cheese. There will be no hot meal option. As it will be an active day, the children may wear comfortable non-school uniform.
