



<u>Treat Day 2025 – Calshot Activity Centre</u> Friday 11th July

Dear Parents and Carers,

As the final few weeks approach us, we are beginning to prepare for Treat Day at Calshot Activity Centre, Southampton on **Friday 11**th **July**. We, and the children, are very excited about this day and can't wait to celebrate what has been an incredible year with them.

Please can all children arrive at school for 7:15am where we will do register and collect any pocket money. We will be leaving school at 7:45am and will be returning to school for a 5:00pm pick up.

Whilst at Calshot, we will be doing numerous activities including: archery, high wires, crate building and ringos. The children will therefore need to come to school wearing appropriate clothing for the day (see the kit list below) and should bring a bag or rucksack with them for their packed lunch, water bottle and extra kit. Please ensure all belongings are clearly named. The children are not permitted to take any electronic devices including phones, tablets or cameras. For health and safety reasons, the children are not permitted to wear any jewellery including earrings and long hair will need to be tied up. Children may be asked to remove jewellery and it will be their responsibility to look after it if this is the case.
