

Year 6 End of Year Treat Day

Dear Parents and Friends of Castle Hill,

With the end of term looming, it is finally time for us to reveal our exciting plans for Treat Day!

As is tradition at CHPS, we have organised a fun finale for the end of year treat for the children. This is a celebration to reward the children for their hard work during Year 6 and to mark the end of their time at CHPS. Treat Day this year will be held on the **Greenbank school fields**, for **both Rooksdown and Greenbank children**, on **Wednesday 15th July**. Your generous donations throughout the year have meant we have been able to book a few external providers to come into school and deliver most of the activities. We would like to thank Rooksdown Fundraising Friends team who have matched the amount raised by Greenbank parent's voluntary donations.

IMPORTANT:

If your child attends the Rooksdown Campus, they will need to be dropped to our Greenbank Campus at 9:00am and, to avoid an overflow of traffic at the end of the day, collected at 2:45pm. They will not be released to walk home on their own and must be collected by a known adult. Please let the admin team know if we need to release your child to an alternative adult e.g. for car-sharing reasons. Staff will be around at 9:00am to direct your children up to the hall where they will be registered. Please collect your child/ren by the external hall doors at 2:45pm.

Greenbank pupils will be expected to arrive to school at the normal time and usual collection arrangements at 3:15pm.

As you are all aware, the weather is forecast to still be in the region of 28-30°C next week. We will therefore have indoor options available, in an air-conditioned classroom, should any children need time out of the sun and to keep calm for a little while and regular water breaks. Staff will be monitoring behaviour and how much strenuous activity the children are doing and, if necessary, will alter activities to ensure everyone is keeping safe. **Please ensure your child has applied sunscreen in the morning before coming on to site, that they have a sunhat with them and a named water bottle.** Any belongings they bring into school on the day need to be kept in a named bag so that we can ensure things do not go missing - as you can imagine, there are going to be a lot of children on site!

To ensure we are keeping everyone safe throughout the day, we are asking all children to please wear their PE kit for Treat Day, to keep as cool as possible and also be appropriate for the activities. For the same reasons, we will be eating lunch in the air-conditioned classrooms from 12:25-12:50pm so all children have time out of the heat.

If your child is eligible for Free School Meals and you would like to order a school lunch for Treat Day, please contact the admin team who will organise this for you. If your child is **not** eligible for FSM, please ensure they bring in a packed lunch from home (no nut products, chocolate, sweets or fizzy drinks please).

We will assume that you consent for your child to take part in all of the listed activities, unless you send a written email to the admin team (admin@chjs.net) by 12pm on Tuesday 14th July.
