

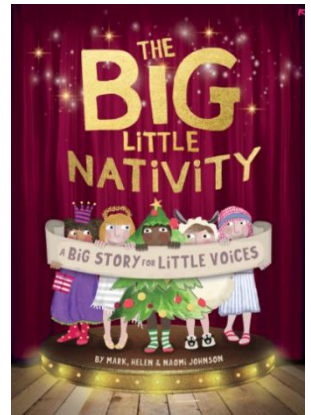

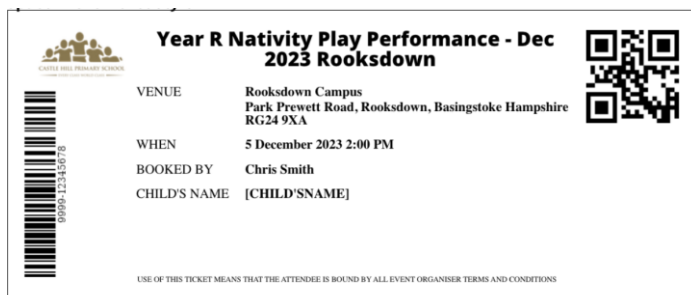
Initially we will allow **two tickets per family** and these will be released on **Monday 24th November at 4pm**. Please respect this allocation so that all families have a chance to attend. If you book tickets and later find that you no longer need them, please use the return feature on the website so they can be redistributed. We will notify parents as and when spare tickets become available.

Tickets are free although we welcome donations at the performance which will go towards covering the costs of putting on the show e.g. Performance Licence, props and staging etc.

1. **To book the tickets please follow the steps below (max. 2 tickets):**

3. You will then find a link for the performance
4. Please click on the link to book your tickets
5. You will receive a booking confirmation email once the form has been completed.

Please note, if there are no tickets available you can put your name on the waiting list.

You will be emailed a ticket that looks something like this:



In the interest of reducing our carbon footprint you don't have to print out your ticket, however please have your ticket available at the door for us to scan. Tickets can be in paper form, on your phone or added to Google and Apple Wallets. Please make sure you have your tickets ready to scan for prompt entry. Unfortunately, admission without a ticket will not be possible as seats in the hall are limited in line with fire restrictions.



Entrance to the hall for the performance will be via the external fire door at the rear of the hall, the main gates at the front of the school doors will open from 1.45pm.
