Year 6 - Trips & Activities for the Year

Dear Parents and Friends of Castle Hill,

The Year 6 team have been busy planning some exciting activities for the children that link to their learning. In true CHPS fashion, they are also planning an extra-special treat day to celebrate the end of their primary school experience! To give you an overview and to help with financial planning, we have planned a mixture of onsite and offsite activities, as transport costs add a significant amount to the cost of a trip. These include a WW2 Dance Workshop, Bikeability and the Treat Day.

The dance workshop will take the children back to the 1940s by learning some fast facts about the Second World War and helping them understand the power of music and dance during the war. They will then learn some steps and routines that accompany popular music from that period.

The children will experience Level 2 Bikeability instruction, which teaches children how to grow more confident with each turn of the pedal. Our expert instructors will lead riders onto quiet roads, to experience “real” cycling.

Level 2 can feel like the biggest step for both you and your child – it’s cycling on the actual road! But with the expert instructors on hand, your child will feel confident and safe in no time at all.

Year 6 Treat Day

The end of year Treat Day is a celebration to reward the children for their hard work during the course of Year 6 and to mark the end of their time at primary school. We will send an update as soon as we have decided on the treat for this year.

In Year 6 we offer the chance for all children to attend a week-long residential trip to Stubbington Study Centre. The dates for this trip are likely to be in our **Autumn 1 Term, September – October 2027**. We start requesting payments for this in Year 5. Based on previous years, we would estimate this to be no more than **£325.00** which covers the cost of transport, meals, accommodation and activities. An interest letter with more information will be sent before Christmas.



Leaver's Disco, Leaver's Hoodie, Leaver's Year Book- Participation is completely optional. However, if you choose to register your child, payment is required.

To remember their time here at Castle Hill Primary School, the Year 6 children will be able to order a Leaver's hoodie. The colour of the hoodie is voted on by the year group and all children's names from both sites are included (with permission from their adults). The cost last year for this was approximately £25.00. The price this year is not yet confirmed.

A team at each site will organise a wonderful year book for the children with memories, photographs and messages. The cost of this is TBC.

The children will all be invited to a Leaver's disco at the end of the school year to celebrate their time with us. This is normally the entire year group from both sites and will be held in one of the halls. The cost for this will approximately £10.00.
