Castle Hill School - Admissions Policy

Castle Hill School is a provision for students identified as having Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND).

Context

Castle Hill School is a Together Learning Trust academy based in Newsome, Huddersfield. Our school provision meets the needs of learners with highly Complex Needs including those with Profound and Multiple Learning Difficulties, Severe Learning Difficulties and those with Multi-Sensory Impairments from the age of 3 to 19.

Admission criteria

- Students have an Education Health and Care Plan or are undergoing statutory assessment.
- The needs of a learner could be met within our school's resources without adversely affecting any other learner currently attending.
- There is a consensus among professionals that a learner would benefit from our provision. Professionals include: School SLT, Kirklees SENDACT and the Kirklees decision making group(DMG).
- Needs are significant and affect most areas of learning.

Applications
