

Art activities

- Make spring collages e.g leaves, flowers, cotton wool (lambs)
- Make baby animal mobiles e.g calves, lambs, chicks
- Oil and water, wax crayon rainbows
- Make paper flowers with pipe cleaners e.g daffodils
- Make a birds nest collage with straw
- Paint your own flower pots, wellingtons
- Expressive painting to topic-based music (spring, weather, earth)
- Using water sprays to make rain pictures
- Make weather wheel chart using paper plates
- Windy art e.g blowing feathers across pages, blowing ping pong balls in paint, using fans
- Make cotton wool clouds with varying weather e.g rainbow ribbons hanging from them
- Make weather themed sensory bottles
- Make a paper mache earth using a balloon
- Exploring use of clay to make magnets, keyrings etc.
- Make sand art bottles

DT activities

- Make rain shakers: putting rice into tubes and sealing ends then decorating tube, listen to sounds made, as it is shook up and down
- Make wind chimes: use string to attach materials together (spoons, wood etc.) hang on trees and listen to them making noise in the wind
- Make stain glass windows: use coloured see through sheets, tear up and stick together, frame with black card and stick up on window, look at colours shining as sun comes through window
- Make fake snow: Add water to fake snow and watch grow, add ice cubes to add cold feel, mould into snowballs
- Make an igloo from ice cubes
- Use recycling to junk model, making animals, robots etc. by sticking items together with tape and glue
- Upcycle old pieces of furniture, painting, upholstering and adding new parts to create a useable resource
- Design posters to remind people to switch off lights and use less water, using paints, colouring pencils etc.
