

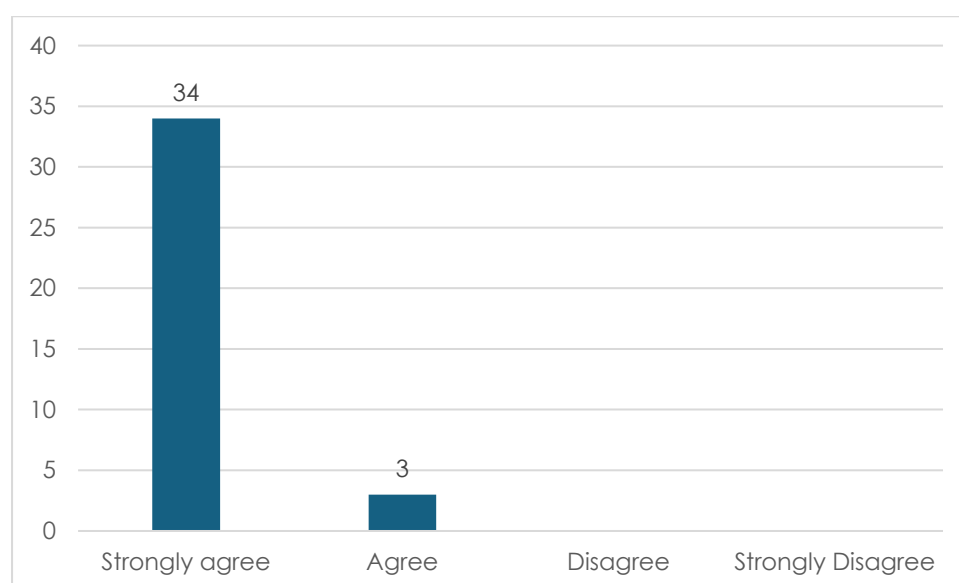
Castle Hill School Parents' Evening October 2025

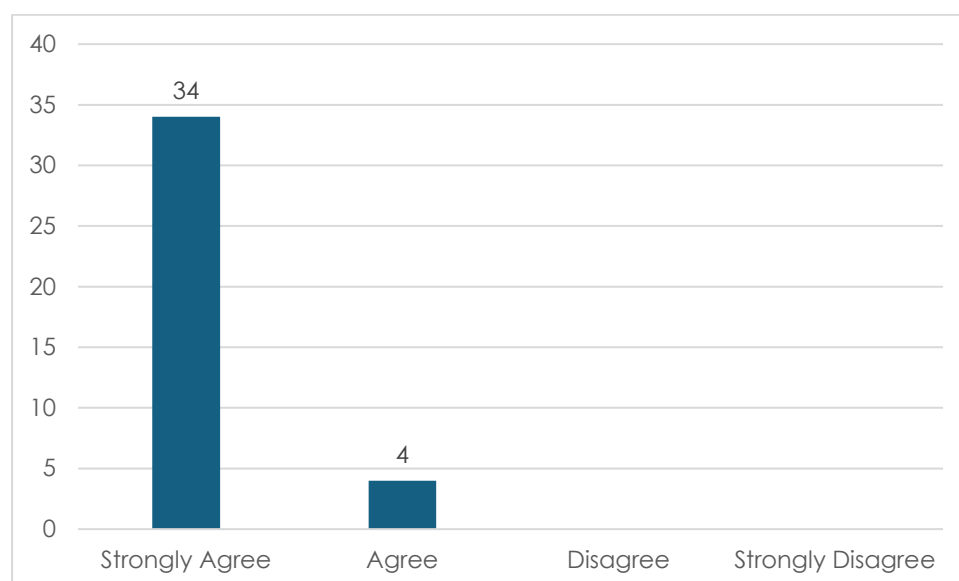

Results of Questionnaire following Parents' Evening (38 Respondents):

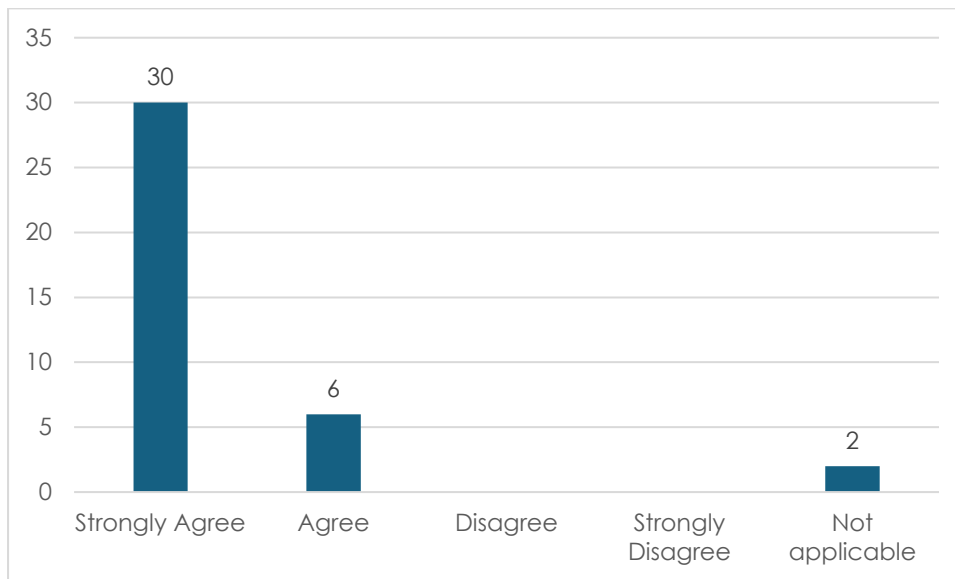
1. My child benefits from being at school.



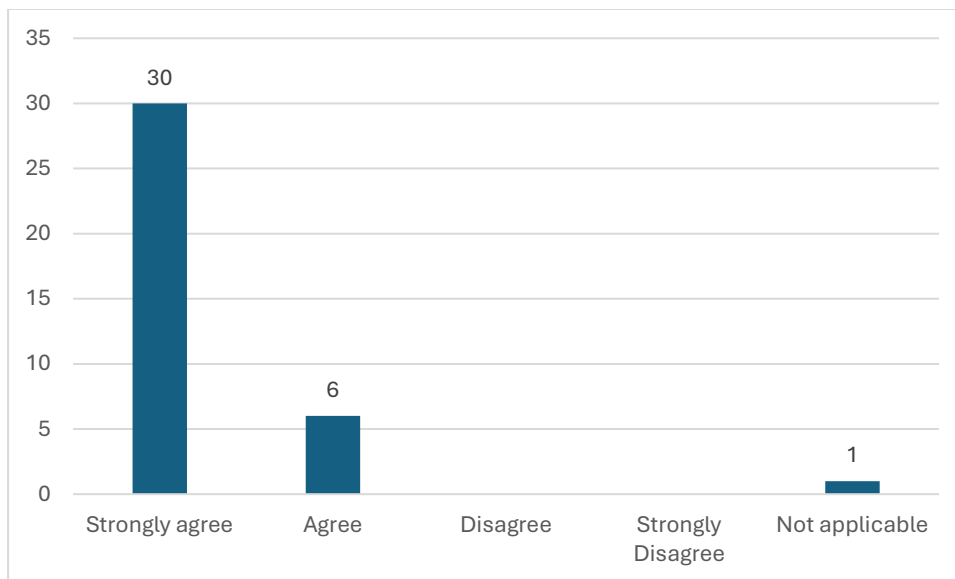
2. I am happy with the learning my child accesses.



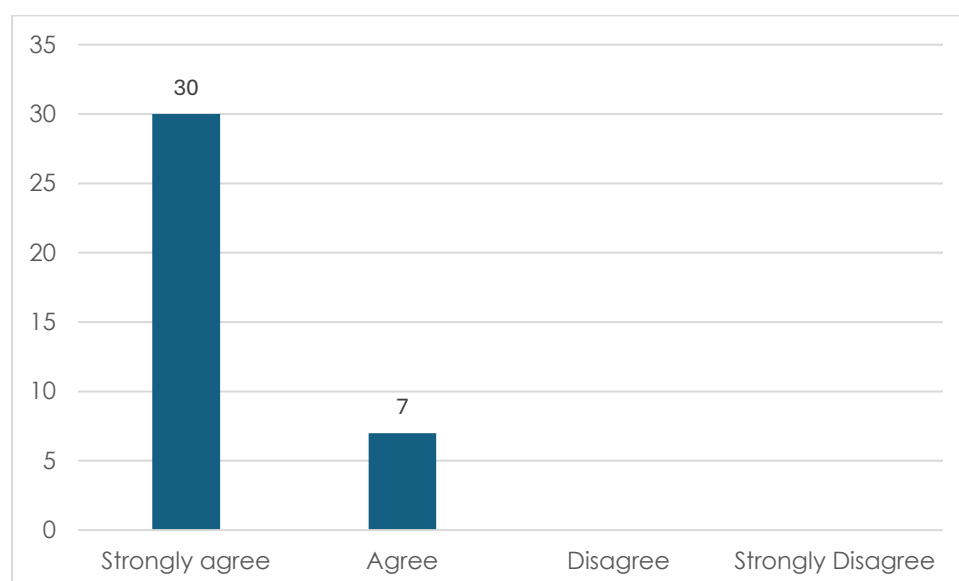
3. School's support last year helped my child transition into their new class.



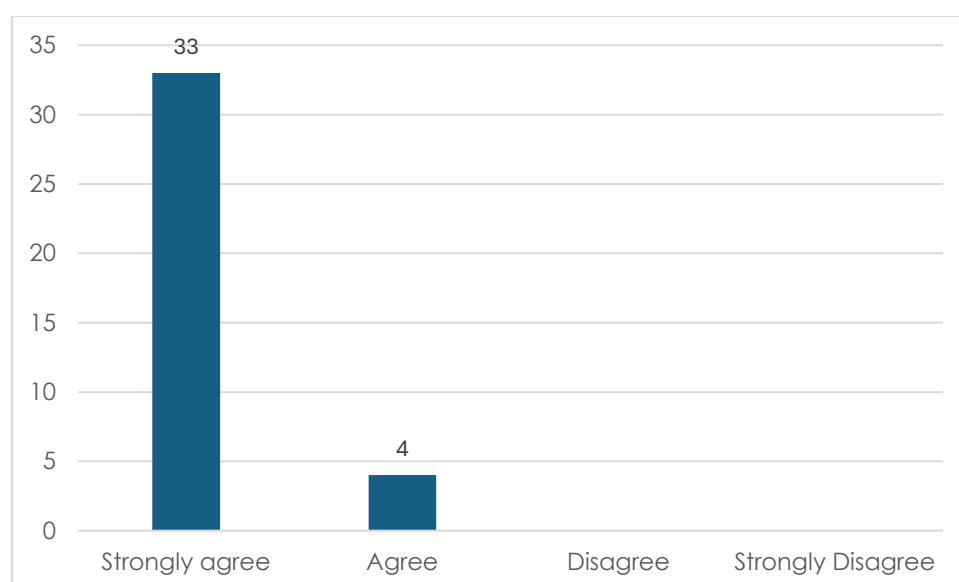
4. Any concerns or issues I have raised so far have been acted upon.
