


Castle Hill School Parents' Evening October 2024



1. My child benefits from being at school.




2. I am happy with the learning my child accesses.








3. School's support last year helped my child transition into their new class.




4. Any concerns or issues I have raised so far have been acted upon.




5. I am happy with communication between home and school.
