


Castle Hill School Parents' Evening October 2022

Parents and carers were invited to attend Parents' Evening either face-to-face, or through Teams or phone call. Parents/carers of 74 pupils attended in person or spoke to the class teacher on the evening itself. Others had attended a recent EHCP review for their child. Class teachers ensured that they contacted all parent/carers of remaining pupils over the following week.

Following Parents' Evening, 39 parents/carers completed a paper copy of the questionnaire.



1. I am happy with the transition arrangements that were made for my child last term.


2. I am happy with the progress my child has made so far this year.





3. 'Next steps' for my child have been made clear.






4. Any concerns or issues I have raised so far have been acted upon.



The following Parent and Carer Information Sessions were held last year in school:

• Early Communication and introduction to Speech and Language Therapy



- Makaton starter
- Health care, including continence and oral health
- Positive Behaviour
- Lifting and Handling 1-1 sessions with Manual Handling Advisor, Penny Townshend
- Sensory regulation

Parents and carers were asked to tick sessions that they would be interested in for this year and to give some idea of availability, where possible, eg days/times that would suit them best. This information is currently being collated.

Parents and carers were asked if they have any other comments or suggestions for how we can improve further.

Replies:

Parents and carers were given the opportunity to request further dialogue, if necessary.

A total of 3 parents expressed a wish to talk further, following the meeting. The class teacher made the initial follow up call, after discussion with a member of the SLT team. In each case, parents expressed their satisfaction with their queries. Opportunities for dialogue remain open for all parents and carers on a daily basis.
