Expectations for school uniform

Pupils are encouraged to wear the correct uniform where possible.

Our students wear a school uniform which consists of a coloured jumper or cardigan. Polo shirt and black/grey trousers or skirt.

Sixth form students are not required to wear uniform although many do.

A positive, collaborative approach is applied, taking into consideration context, need and cost and the school will work closely with all to arrive at a mutually acceptable outcome. Retailers offer "Easy On" garments, and some have been adapted for the special needs community. School supports parents' choice to purchase non-branded uniform to meet their children's physical and sensory needs.

Parents and carers are expected to make sure their child's clothing is clean, and that every item is clearly labelled with the child's name and is in the best possible condition.
