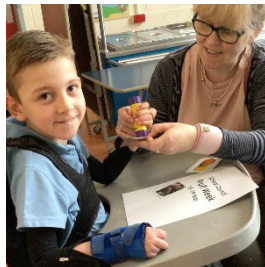


Since the last Governor update, we have held ...

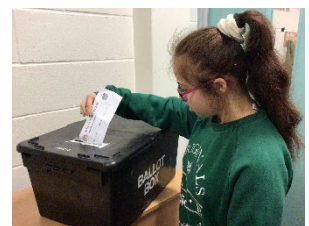
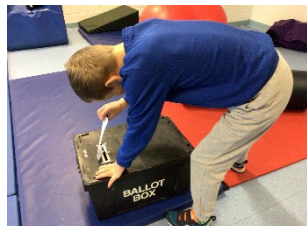
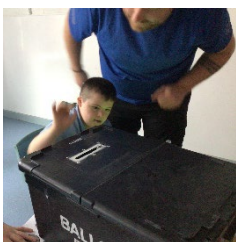
**Pupil Voice and School Dinners:**
