Membership of SPIN (Sporting Partnerships and Initiatives from Newsome) and SPIN meeting cover 2 days	£936.00	Our SPIN membership has enabled close support from the School Games Organiser in the piloting of Motor Activity Training Programme (MATP). This pilot forms part of the PE Action Plan, and is informing the new subject Mastery targets. The School Games Organiser has attended MATP sessions in school over a five week period. We have also been joined by students from Newsome Academy. These sessions culminated in the MATP event – where student athletes competed against their own targets in a range of events. The event was attended by families and students from Newsome Academy.
Equipment purchases (rebound therapy)	£211.16	Purchases have included specialist cushioning and wedge, to support students' positioning, a light projector to enhance the sensory experience, and a "peanut" therapy ball, as additional support or to challenge students' vestibular processing.
Equipment purchases (hydrotherapy)	£14.77	Foil blankets for use in evacuation or for sensory exploration.
Equipment to enable Linear glider (swing)	£229.00	Equipment to enable use of a new swing for the Sensory Regulation room. This will promote calming movements, while enabling staff to work on challenging students' motor planning, balance and coordination.
Training for Hydrotherapy staff	£1,397.49	STA Pool Emergency Responder training for colleagues who lead on hydrotherapy sessions.
Specialist "Rocking Horse" chair	£301	This supports a child with their sensory processing and regulation needs. Initial findings indicate that it is having a dramatic effect on their ability to self-regulate and access learning for longer periods through the school day.
Large beanbag and fold out recliner	£322.60	To create a calm corner in a classroom, allowing pupils with additional sensory processing needs to self-select calming sensory feedback in the classroom, without the need to access specialist rooms, meaning that their independence is promoted as well as their access to learning activities.
Omnis	£13,146.25	Ongoing specialist PE coaching, working with a wide range of classes whilst promoting strategies for class staff in supporting accessible physical challenges for all pupils.
