| Equipment purchases (hall equipment)  | £2103.13   | Beams and benches to update our daily "ABC" course, adding extra differentiation to enable wider access.   |
| Equipment purchases (Sensory Regulation Room)   | £657       | Replacement swing and associated equipment for the Sensory Regulation room. This will promote calming movements, while enabling staff to work on challenging students' motor planning, balance and coordination.   |
