| Membership of SPIN (Sporting Partnerships and Initiatives from Newsome) | £500 | To support school sports and activity including inter and intra school competition. Includes advice from School Sports Leader and sessions with SPIN staff to provide specialist training. |
| SPIN meeting cover 2 days | £250 | To update staff training and knowledge, to liaise with other schools about events (and see above) |
| Equipment purchases Update ABC | £1000 | To develop the range of activities within "ABC". (Morning "Agility, Balance and Coordination" course) |
| Equipment purchases Update specialist sensory equipment | £1500 | To extend challenge to sensory learners in order to challenge their physical exploration. Also, to support individual students' sensory regulation. |
| Cover for Hydro Lifesaver Trainer | £600 | This will fund release to enable ongoing training of staff and of new staff |
| Rebound Therapy training (2 days) | £2964 | To update skills of previously trained staff and to train new staff |
| Training Hydro Lifesaver trainer | £790 | To train a colleague in leading on in-house lifesaver training |
| Specialist sports coaching (Omniscircumvado CIC) | £7700 | "Omnis" specialist sports coaching. Ongoing specialist PE coaching, working with a wide range of classes whilst promoting strategies for class staff in supporting accessible physical challenges for all pupils. |
