### Heatwave Measures

The weather continues to be hot, and we have been adjusting our routines to help the children to feel comfortable. With temperatures continuing to be high next week, these will remain in place. This includes children coming into school in **PE kit**, if they wish. This does not mean own clothes, and we would appreciate your support in enforcing this with our children.

You can help to be taking the following precautions:

- Ensuring your child attends school with sunscreen already applied and a bottle with them should they need to reapply.
- Ensuring your child has a refillable water bottle with them each day.
- Ensuring your child has a hat.
- It may also be beneficial to **not** bring jumpers into school. They are not required, and we have had a big increase in lost jumpers.

## Be safe this summer

Travelling abroad? Stay safe around animals to protect your family from rabies.

### What is rabies?

Rabies is a virus that affects mammals, including dogs and people. It is deadly but preventable.



### How rabies spreads

Rabies is spread in the saliva of infected animals through:



bites

scratches

licks

### How to stay safe

- Don't touch or approach unknown dogs or cats
- Check the rabies risk at your destination and consider pre-travel vaccination
- Never disturb dogs when they are eating, sleeping or with their puppies to reduce the risk of bites
- Avoid dog bites, scratches and licks

### If a dog bites you:

- Wash**  
Wash the wound with soap and running water for 15 minutes
- Apply**  
Apply antiseptic, if available
- Go**  
Go to the hospital

### Did you know?

- Around 59,000** people die from rabies every year worldwide. Children are most at risk.
- 99%** of human rabies cases are linked to contact with infected dogs

While rabies is rare in the UK, it remains a serious risk in many popular holiday destinations. Mission Rabies works around the world to end rabies through dog vaccination and education.
