### End of Day Collection Arrangements

If you arrange for another adult to collect your child, you must inform the school office by phone or email. If possible, please also let your child know in the morning what the collection arrangements will be at the end of the school day.

Your child will not be allowed to leave with anyone else if the school has not been notified in advance.

If the person collecting your child does not have prior parental permission, the school will contact the main carer to obtain consent before allowing the child to leave. In the meantime, your child will be taken back into school and will remain there until we have been able to confirm the arrangements.
