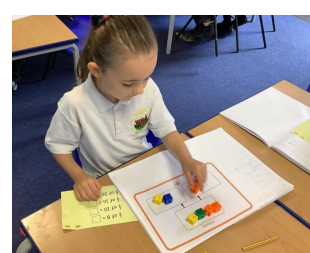
Fantastic Fayre Festivities: Donations Needed!

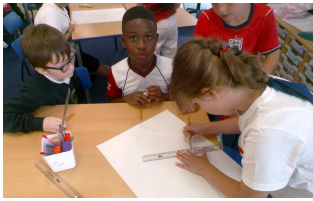

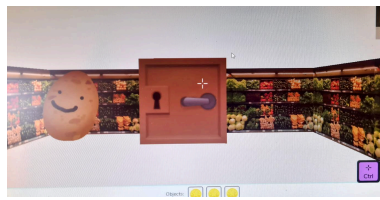
Flying High for England!
