This week's winners of the best attendance prize are the children in Miss Spencer's class. Well done everyone!

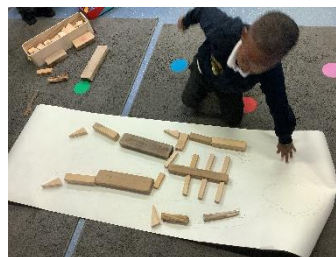


### Tuesday Poppy Group Meeting
