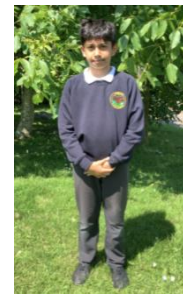
Year 3&4 Scientists

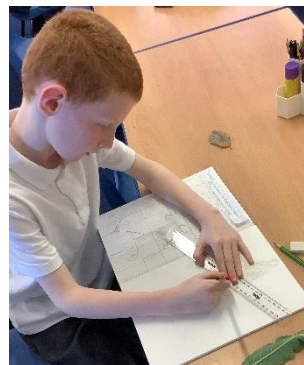
