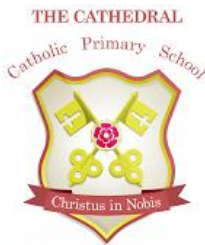




Maths

As scientists, we will be collecting and analysing weather data. We will continue to build our knowledge of the animal groups; mammals, fish, birds, amphibians and reptiles.

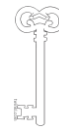


Geography

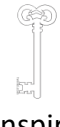
Computing
