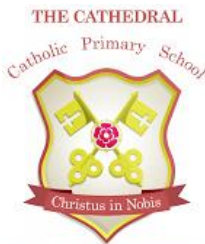
History

As historians, we will be discussing the question 'Would you rather play with old toys or new toys?' To support us with this discussion we will look at many different toys and decided on the similarities and differences.



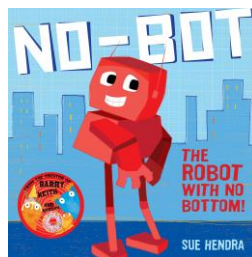
Computing
