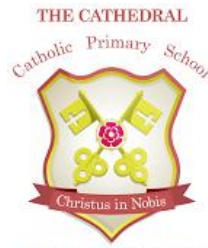


Maths

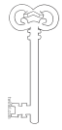

English

As readers and writers, we will begin by reading *The Mousehole Cat* and studying how language is used to create powerful images which we will then use in our own writing. Following this, we will learn how to write an explanation text and use the skills we develop to write explanations for the water cycle and the life cycle of a frog.



RE

In R.E., we will learn how the Good News about Jesus is spread 'To the Ends of the Earth'. We will explore the role of St Peter in the early Church and how Pope Leo XIV is his successor. We will then look at the central beliefs in the Apostles' Creed before learning about the Communion of Saints and Mary as Queen of Heaven.

Science

As scientists, we will continue to explore the properties of solids, liquids and gases. We will learn about how materials change between these states, particularly the processes of evaporation and condensation. Finally, we will apply this learning to explaining how the water cycle works (linked to English).



History

As historians, we will explore the events leading up to and around the Lancashire Witch Trials of 1612. After investigating a range of primary and secondary sources, we will use what we have learnt to debate and discuss the question 'Should the Pendle Witches Have Been Killed?'.

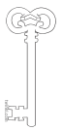

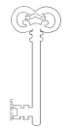
PSHE
