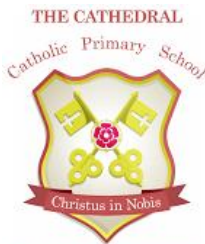




Maths

English

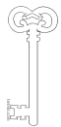

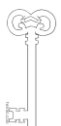
