P.E.

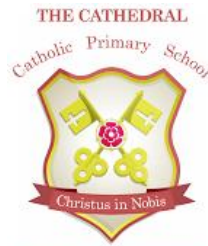
As sports people, we will continue to develop athletics and striking the ball and fielding.

As artists we will be creating different effects on fabric using tie dye techniques.

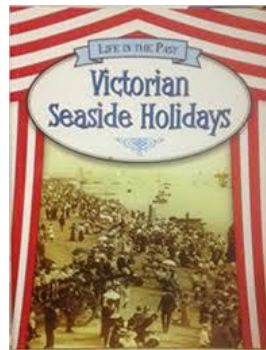
History
