Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Year Four!

I feel excited to be teaching your child this year and am looking forward to getting to know them and helping them to unlock their full potential. I will be the main teacher in Year 4 this year and Mrs Jones and Miss Webb will be our Teaching Assistants. Mrs Verden will have the class on Thursday mornings while I have my planning and preparation time.

PE day will be every Wednesday and **swimming** will be every Friday. Year 4 must come to school in their PE kit on Wednesdays and Fridays please. Please take earrings out on PE and swimming days.

Homework

Daily reading – In Year Four, we continue with daily reading at home. Your child should be reading for at least 10 minutes every day – please sign their planner to show they have been reading as this will help them to work towards gaining their reading key. Please encourage your child to record books they have read that are not from school as it is great to see what books they enjoy.

Spelling – Children will have spelling words in their planner every week to write out and practise. These are taken from the Year 3/4 statutory spelling list and spelling rules. They will use Purple Mash in school to practise words linked to spelling rules.

Maths – Learning and knowing all times tables facts is important in Year 4 as it is a building block for future learning. Please spend 5 minutes every day chanting times tables and giving quick fire questions. Your child will know which times table they need to practise. All times tables are on the back of this letter – please use them!

Communication

We will continue to update the school website with our class news. Please remember to check your emails regularly to keep in touch with what is happening in school.

As we try to be a paperless school, please ensure that the office have your up-to-date email address and that you have access to Arbor.

There is an important 'Meet the Teacher' and Online Safety Meeting for parents of children in Year 4 on Wednesday 9th September at 3:30pm in Year 4 classroom. It is crucial you attend as recent changes about how we keep our children safe online may prevent your child accessing the internet in school unless the meeting is attended.
