Late pick ups

We appreciate that unforeseen circumstances can occasionally result in parents being late to pick up children from school. Please ring the school office if this is the case. We are very understanding of one offs as it can happen to anyone.

However, if children are not collected on several different occasions a £20 Emergency Supervision fee will be charged for every 30 minutes after 3.30pm. This is to cover staffing costs. Teaching staff often have training courses, clubs, paperwork, marking and meetings that mean they are not available to supervise your child. After school club is often full so they cannot always join that, and this needs to be booked ahead of time. This will start from Monday 9th February.
