Parents Evening – bookings open on Friday 1st March after school.

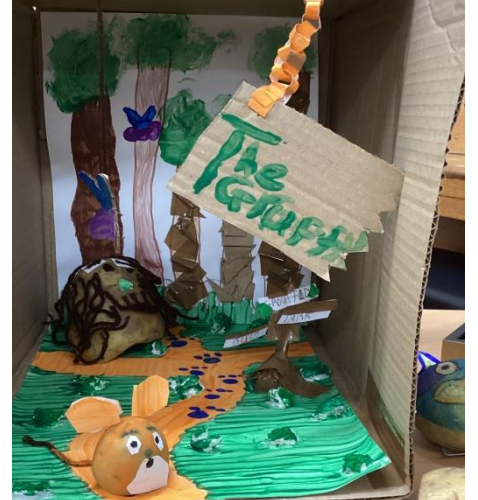
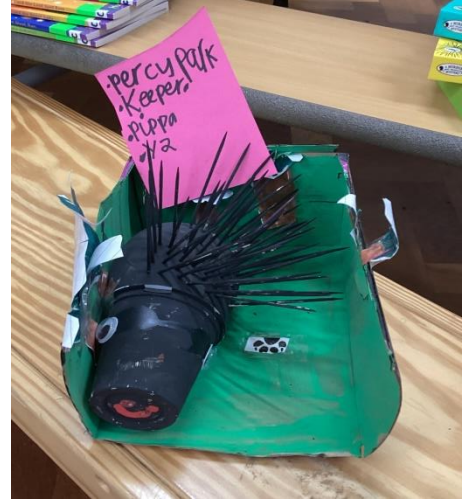
