Below is how some of the money has been spent. They are looking for more volunteers for the Christmas fair as this is the biggest fundraiser. #### **Financial Report**

#### Income

- Total income for the year: £5,389!
- Biggest fundraiser was the Christmas Fayre, which raised nearly £3,500

#### Spend

- Spend on running activities was £2,150
- We spent £1,728 on our children and community in addition to these activities, e.g. new school football kit
- VR goggles headsets and contingency grant committed for 23/24

#### Funds

- After taking account of additional running costs (e.g. licences and subscriptions), the net profit for the PTA in 2022/23 was £1,225
- Together with cash already held in the bank account, we currently have c.£10,000 funds
- The PTA is working closely with teachers to identify the best opportunities for investing these funds in our children and our school
