Are you missing out?! Free School Meals Pupil Premium Funding

We believe a number of our parents may be missing out on claiming free school meals and pupil premium.

You can claim and your child will receive a free daily meal, free school uniform and discounted trips if you claim

- Universal Credit
- Income based Jobseekers' Allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit – household income less than £16,190
- Support under the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Other Income Support & benefits

Please visit the Office and speak to Mrs Phillips/Miss Barnes if you would like to find out if your child is eligible.

End Of The Day Routine
