



Home School Agreement

Lancaster High School are committed to providing an excellent educational experience for your child. To ensure we are working together to make sure your child succeeds in all aspects of their life, we ask you to pledge support in a number of ways that are outlined in this home school agreement.

As a school, we agree to:

1. to provide a secure, happy and safe place for your child to work in
2. to help your child to develop as an individual, knowing right from wrong and adopting positive attitudes that will last their whole life
3. to provide an education that meets your child's needs and prepares them for life beyond school
4. to provide records and information in grade cards that show how your child is progressing
5. to arrange progress evenings with teachers and be happy to see you by appointment when you have concerns or questions
6. to do our best to make sure your child is working hard and using their ability to the full
7. to let you know if your child is having difficulties in school or we are concerned about health and wellbeing
8. to set regular homework and encourage pupils to learn for themselves inside and outside school
9. to provide extra-curricular opportunities for your child to develop their skills and talents outside of the classroom
10. to ensure pupil receive careers information, education, advice and guidance to support them in their next steps.

As parents, we ask you to agree:

1. to ensure your child wears the correct uniform each day with pride
2. to support the school in ensuring your child follows the Behaviour for Learning Policy, has a positive attitude to school work and takes responsibility for their own academic progress
3. to ensure your child attends school every day on time, has enough sleep and has the correct equipment for each day
4. to support the school with homework by making sure your child has time to produce their 'best' work and checking on homework set on Class Charts
5. to attend progress evenings
6. to contact us if there are any changes at home which may affect your child in school
7. to encourage your child to take part in at least one extra-curricular club a week and takes the opportunity to attend school trips and events
8. to support and encourage your child in independent learning through appropriate use of television, the media, computer programs, reading and research.

As a Lancaster High School pupil, we ask you:

1. to be respectful of other pupils and adults in school
2. to come to school regularly and on time every day, aiming for 97% attendance and no unauthorised absence
3. to bring your exercise books, your pencil case and any other kit or equipment you need in an appropriate school bag
4. to dress in correct uniform and have pride in your appearance
5. to work hard in all lessons and encourage other pupils to do the same
6. to follow the Behaviour for Learning Policy, work to meet our expectations and accept any sanctions that are given
7. to travel to and from school in uniform and act in a sensible, safe and polite way at all times
8. to complete all homework set to the best of your ability
9. to attend at least one extra-curricular club a week.
